This MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING is hereby made and entered into by and between KDK COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING, Departments of Mechanical and Electrical Engineering, hereinafter referred to as KDKCE and OWECO OCEAN WAVE ENERGY COMPANY, hereinafter referred to as OWECO.

WHEREAS: To further a potential educational and business arrangement, it may be necessary for one or both of the parties hereto to disclose confidential information to the other. Herein a party receiving confidential information is referred to as "RECIPIENT" and a party supplying information is referred to as "DISCLOSER". The proposed confidential information relates to converting ocean waves to electricity in India. Dominant patent rights remain with OWECO. Other intellectual and tangible property rights arising from the potential arrangement shall be subject to negotiation and hereafter appended.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing recitals and the mutual covenants contained herein, the parties, intending to be legally bound hereby, have agreed and do hereby agree as follows:

Neither party is under an obligation by reason of this Agreement to supply confidential information to RECIPIENT and RECIPIENT is under no obligation to receive such information.

Should DISCLOSER supply confidential information to RECIPIENT pursuant to this Agreement, RECIPIENT and its offices and employees will retain said confidential information in confidence with the same degree of care it affords to its own extremely important confidential information and will not disclose such confidential information to third parties without prior written consent of DISCLOSER, and RECIPIENT agrees to use any confidential information received from DISCLOSER only for the specific purpose of furthering the potential or existing business arrangement between the parties.

Confidential information as used herein will include any technical information which is disclosed in documentary form to RECIPIENT, with each section thereof clearly marked before "CONFIDENTIAL BEGINS" and after "CONFIDENTIAL ENDS", or which with RECIPIENT'S prior consent is orally disclosed to RECIPIENT and which is memorialized in writing within 30 days of such oral disclosure in a document, each section of which is clearly marked "CONFIDENTIAL" and delivered to RECIPIENT. Confidential information shall not include the following:

any information which RECIPIENT can demonstrate was already known to it prior to the date upon which such information is or has been disclosed to it;

any information disclosed to RECIPIENT or its officers or employees by a third party subsequent to the date from which such information was disclosed to RECIPIENT by DISCLOSER without violation by such third party of any duty to DISCLOSER;

any information which is now public knowledge, or which becomes public knowledge, as a result of an act of someone other than RECIPIENT, its officers or employees; or

any information which is independently developed by the RECIPIENT without utilizing confidential information obtained from the DISCLOSER.

Should DISCLOSER supply confidential information to RECIPIENT, said information will be made available only to those employees of RECIPIENT who have need of such information.

At the request of DISCLOSER, RECIPIENT will return all documents provided by DISCLOSER, except one archive set to be used by RECIPIENT only if a disagreement concerning this Agreement arises between the parties.

This Agreement will remain in effect for (5) five years from the effective date. The obligation to maintain confidential information confidential shall continue until seventeen (17) years from the time the information is first disclosed to RECIPIENT.


