

KDK College of Engineering (KDKCE) in Nagpur organized a Road Safety Awareness Program today in association with ISTE, IQAC, and IIC. The program aimed to educate students about the importance of safe driving and responsible behavior on the road.


Justice Abhay Sapre, Former Judge of the Supreme Court and Chairman of the Road Safety Committee, served as the esteemed Chief Guest. He delivered a thought-provoking speech emphasizing the gravity of road accidents in India. Highlighting the alarming statistic of 1.5 lakh annual fatalities, he urged students to prioritize safety by following traffic rules, wearing helmets, no Over speeding and avoiding distractions like mobile phones while driving. He also encouraged them to become ambassadors of road safety by educating their families and communities. Some of the important issues highted were Road accidents claim a significant number of lives in India, with a worrying number occurring within the 18-45 age group, Responsible driving practices, including helmet usage, seatbelt compliance, and avoiding distractions, are crucial for safety, Educational institutions play a vital role in fostering road safety awareness among students and communities, Collaborative efforts from all stakeholders are essential to create a safer road environment for everyone.

These points have been also discussed during the session: Justice Sapre also stated that RTO/Police be directed to undertake drives oriented towards ensuring College/Tuition going children commuting by their own vehicles should have valid licenses, registration, insurance etc. It was emphasised that the Education Institutes were reckoned of discouraging unsafe road practices such as driving without helmet etc. by involving parents of the students for their overall counselling.

The program commenced with a welcome address by Principal Dr. Valsson Varghese. Other dignitaries gracing the occasion included RTO of Nagpur Rajabhau Gite, Dy. RTO Ravindra Bhuyar, Asst. RTO Sneha Mendhe and Vice Principal Dr. A. M. Badar.

Justice Sapre's session was accompanied by compelling video presentations and data-driven insights on various accident types. He interacted with students and faculty, emphasizing the collaborative role of transport authorities, police, public, and educational institutions in creating mass awareness and reducing road accident fatalities.

Professor Venus Bower ably compered the event, while students, faculty, and non-teaching staff actively contributed to its success. The program concluded with renewed commitment from the KDKCE community to promote responsible road behavior and create a safer environment for all.

### रस्ते अपघातातील मृत्यू कमी व्हावेत

रस्ते अपघातांतील मृत्यूचे प्रमाण कमी व्हावे, म्हणून प्रादेशिक परिवहन कार्यालय, अख्यअवली यांच्या संयुक्त विद्यमाने जनजागृती केली जात असून नंदनवनमधील केडीके अभियांत्रिकी महाविद्यालयात कार्यक्रम घेण्यात आला. प्रमुख अतिथी रस्ता सुरक्षा विभागाचे अध्यक्ष तथा सर्वोच्च न्यायालयाचे निवृत्त न्या. अश्वय सौं होते. ते म्हणाले की, भारतातील रस्ते अपघातात दरवर्षी लाखो मृत्यू पावतात. हेल्मेट न वापरणे, अतिवेगाने गाडी चालविणे, वाहन चालकिताना फोनवर बोलण्याने तडध विचलित होऊन अपघात होतात. त्यामुळे या गोष्टी टाळण्यात ह्यात. रस्ते अपघातात मृत्यूचे प्रमाण १८-४५ कोटीतलील पुढेकडे अधिक असून, हे चिंताजनक आहे. त्यामुळे वाहन चालकांच्या कुटुंबीयांना शिक्षित करून रस्ता सुरक्षेचे राजदूत होण्यास त्यांना प्रोत्साहित करायला हवे. स्वतःच्या वाहनाने प्रवास करणाऱ्या मुलांकडे वैध परवाने, नोंदणी, विमा आवरपक आहे, असेही त्यांनी सोंवटी सांगितले. नागपूरचे आरटीओ राजाभाऊ गिरे, उय आरटीओ रवींद्र भुषार, सहायक आरटीओ स्नेहा मेंडे, उपजाचार्य डॉ. ए. एम. बदर पांचोळी भाषणे झाली. माहितीपट प्रसारण तसेच विद्यार्थी-प्राध्यापक संवाद झाला. कार्यक्रमाची सुरुवात प्राचार्य डॉ. वेंत्सन वर्गीस पांचव्या स्वागतपर भाषणाने झाली. संचालन प्रा. व्हीनस बोवर यांनी केले.
